Personally appeared before me, the undersigned Clerk of the Circuit Court of said County *Ollie Tolar*

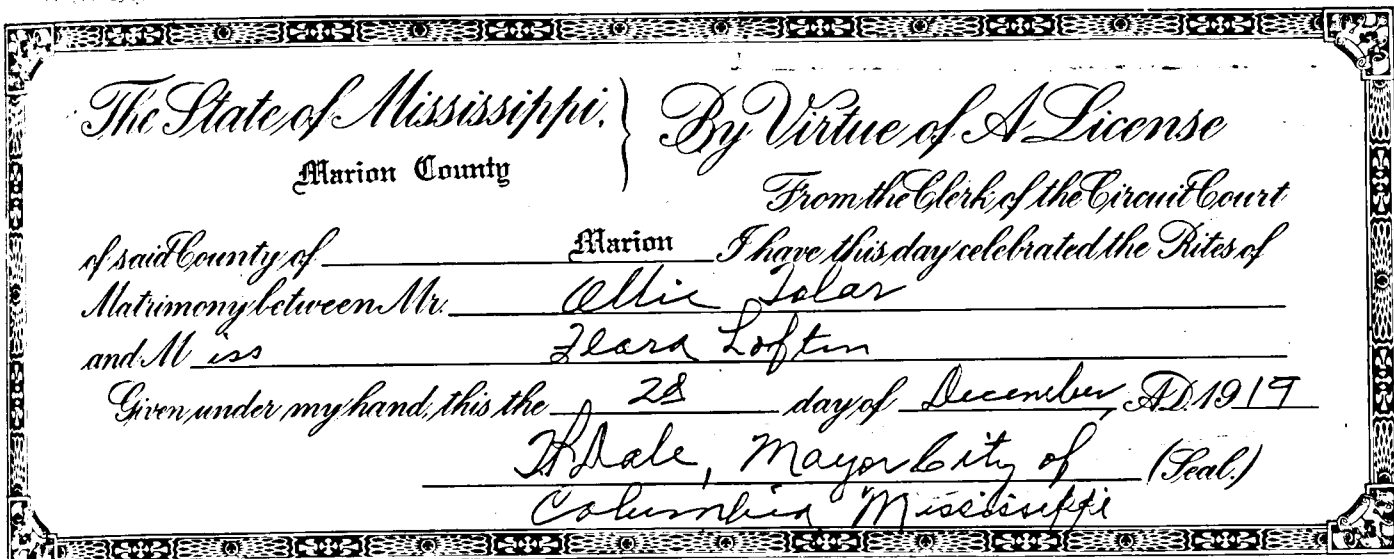
who has applied for a Marriage License, and makes oath that there is no legal cause to obstruct his Marriage with *Miss Flora Loftin* a resident of said County,
